

Opus Projektor Licensing



How to get a license for the Opus Projektor

This description deals with the licensing of the OPUS Projektor Tool for programming the TConn series. Without a license, the tool can only be used as a demo application.

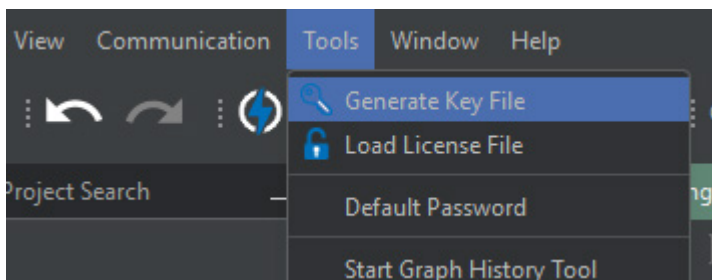
The demo limits the programming to a maximum of two pages and five variables that can be created.

After downloading the Projektor Tool from your myMRS area, the key must be licensed by MRS Electronic GmbH & Co. KG. To create your key, the demo application must first be installed.

Step 1: Create a key file

To do this, open the separate window under **Tools → Generate Key File**.

After entering a name and storage location, the key can be saved.



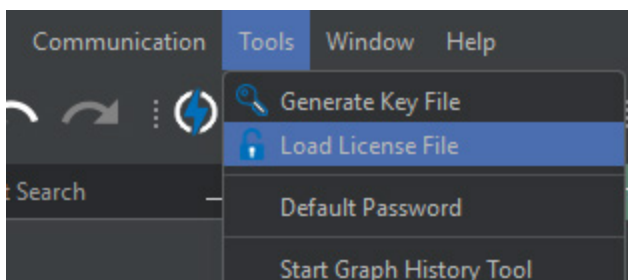
Step 2: Get a license key

To receive the license file, you must first have purchased the license from MRS Electronic GmbH & Co. KG. Then send the key you created in Step 1 to support@mrs-electronic.com.

After checking and generating a license, the new key file with activated license will be sent back to you.

Step 3: Load the license file

After the license file was received, open the menu **Tools → Load License File**.



In the dialog, browse to the location of the license file, select it and confirm by clicking **Select License File**.

Now the program is fully licensed. The title of the program in the title bar should have changed from **Demo** to **Licensed**.
